Tereza Waldejer has in her MA thesis done comparison and made use of a methodology for doing this in a way that shows that her research was carefully conducted.

The qualitative research in Waldejer's MA thesis has been developed by using various research methods, such as participant observation, unstructured interviews, case study and comparative analysis.

Her thesis deals with the topic of prostitution and combines structured research and choice of relevant theoretical perspective. Her work is done by analysis built on both self-reflection and personal analysis and observations. Her results appeared from both interviews with social workers and with women in prostitution.

Tereza Waldejer has in her MA thesis made use of well-defined research questions. The structure of the thesis is organized in a good way. Challenges around use of methodology and presentation are conducted well. It is obvious that it is difficult to compare the socially relevant issue of prostitution in two European countries. Although the MA thesis could have had a more focused and balanced outcome in some parts, it is done in a way that provides understanding. The MA thesis reaches the goal of comparison of both differences and similarities between prostitution in the Czech Republic and Norway.
