### **Questions and comments**

### Critical comments and overall contributions, total value of the thesis

There is one point which is not clear. Dealing with the results of the second part of the questionnaire, the author states that "Almost 9% believe that LAG BP is fully addressing its

challenges to the problems and needs for the area. Only 3 municipalities claim that the challenges do not respond to the problem" (p.7 of the compendium). It is not clear, why relative and absolute numbers are mixed. 3 respondents correspond to 13,6% and is more than the alleged 9% (which corresponds to two respondents) which are fully satisfied.

The practical contribution of the thesis is evident. The author delivers a good survey about the situation as it is seen by the majors of the concerned cities. However, in some points a qualitative research (for example with regard to the administrative burden of European projects for smaller municipalities) seems necessary in order to improve the assistance which can be given. These points for further research are not so well developed in the thesis.

- 2. Given the results of your research, which recommendations can you give to the Czech State, to the EU and to the voters on local, national and European level?
