Dominik learned the basic specimen preparation techniques for SBF-SEM and TEM, including preparation of glass knives, sectioning of semi-thin sections and demanding procedure of trimming and mounting of epoxy blocks on SBF stubs. He mastered basic TEM, SEM operation skills. Under supervision of Tomáš Bílý, he evaluated TEM image contrast of ultrathin sections using different approaches. He worked systematically, consulted his project regularly; he was initiative in solving the goals of the thesis.
