Short characteristics of the thesis

The thesis examines the topic of class and marriage in one of Jane Austen's best novels *Pride and Prejudice.* First it needs to be said that the material for this particular investigation was well chosen as *Pride and Prejudice* offers much to discuss regarding this topic. The author of the thesis locates the issue of class and marriage in the wider concept of the Regency Era. The thesis is structured as follows: after a short general introduction the author moves to close reading of the novel and then sums up her insights in the conclusion.

Overall assessment

The thesis is well laid out and written, despite some minor glitches, in good English. The topic is well chosen and the author's inquiry is supported by a sound research into secondary sources. As the supervisor of this thesis I must praise Martina for her truly independent work. Her bachelor thesis is a fine foundation for further scholarly work.

I do recommend the thesis for defence and suggest that it be graded as **excellent**.
