

Průběh obhajoby bakalářské práce:

Jakub Remeš wrote on the New Journalism works of nonfiction about the 1972 Presidential Election by Hunter S. Thompson and Norman Mailer. Both works describe the failures of the Democratic nominee George McGovern to defeat President Richard M. Nixon who had grossly failed to keep his 1968 election campaign promises (among other things he did not end the war but extended it substantially). Mr. Remeš added that he should have written much more about Nixon than he did, but noted that the books he analyzed focussed more on the failure of the Democratic party than Nixon's own personality or policies. The use of Mailer's "extra reporter" named "Aquarius" was addressed as well as a questionable application of the term stream-of-consciousness narrative technique to the prose of Norman Mailer. After a brief discussion it was concluded to be assessed as a strong "velmi dobře" work in the evaluation.
