

Průběh obhajoby bakalářské práce:

The Candidate emphasized in her presentation the distinction in Sir Walter Scott's historical novels Rob Roy and Ivanhoe the historical elements from the fictive and romantic parts which enlivened the plots. She pointed out how Scott had studied and collected folklore and orally-transmitted ballads from Scottish country folk which led him to study history. In his prolific production of novels, Scott sought popularity over historical accuracy. The candidate pointed out the historical vs. fictional heroes being convincingly portrayed in the proper historical settings. The answer to one question regarding the significance of history in Scott's fiction included, besides its entertaining value, the fact that it helped readers to more closely identify with the nation. (Scott was also a royalist, not interested in promoting Scottish independence). In answering a comparative question, she regards Ivanhoe to be less realistic and less historically accurate with much more supernatural and impossible events taking place.
