The presented theses “Changes in European landscapes. What are driving forces of the changes in European landscapes?” have together 76 pages and are divided into 7 logical coherent

chapters, covering problems of Landscape changes, sociological concept of regional identity, description of the area of interest, methodology and results based on quantitative as well as qualitative methods, discussion, and conclusion. Each of them is carefully formulated and tied to each other. So we're witnesses of the very good structure of the theses.

The aim of the theses was finally focused on the question of how the inhabitants of Postoloprty perceive their environment and how do they identify with their region. If the identification with the territory is low, what steps could help to increase it? It was developed into 6 theory-based research questions, which became the basis for a quantitative survey and qualitative interview. The data operationalization, data processing, etc. seems to me on a very good level, the author knows what to do and why to use just this method. It gives assumptions for good results in terms of their validity and reliability.

Author Amálie Hrdinová shows her ability to analyze complicated multidimensional social facts of local identity in the context of contemporary scientific discourse, to make her own research, and integrate her results into reasonable conclusions and recommendations.
