#### Critical comments and overall contributions, total value of the thesis

The author has chosen an innovative research topic of great relevance, taking into account current tendencies on the level of professional communication. According to very current challenges of the re-organization of communication in companies and institutions, the study puts the focus on virtual team collaboration in the context of the COVID10 pandemic.

The author provides a broad theoretical background, presenting definitions, terms and concepts that are relevant for understanding her research. The key notions she presents are strongly focused on the research question. The theoretical part of the thesis contains a good reflection about the key notion "team" and the differences between teams and working groups. The author defines her own working definition based on research literature. In this context, she highlights the complexity of the notion "virtual teams" which then undergoes a profound critical reflection. The state of the art chapter shows that the author has familiarized herself with current and relevenat research in her domain, enabling her to reflect her own results.

The methodological part contains a very detailed discussion of the methodological background, with references to research literature and the explanation and justification of methodologal choices with regards to the reserach topic. The qualitative, semi-structured interviews the author has conducted allow to gain very detailed insights into the challenges of virtual team collaboration. Based on the well-reflected data analysis, the author develops suggestions for improvement concerning virtual team collaboration that could be implemented by companies and institutions.
