

Průběh obhajoby bakalářské práce:

The defence of the bachelor thesis proceeded smoothly with the candidate introducing the comparative analysis of the parodic satire by Flann O'Brien in his novel The Poor Mouth as the most famous book ever written in Gaelic Irish, The Islandman by Tomás O'Grada. The candidate approached the defensive approach of Irish nationalists against the prejudicial misrepresentation of the stereotypical drunken Irish peasant "laddy" as often presented in English literatures, and how O'Brien also played with the primitivism of the peasant life in Ireland. The candidate then proceeded to address the questions from the opponent and the supervisor concerning the nature and examples of black humor, the secondary critical approaches regarding authenticity of The Islandman and the primitivism critique. The final assessment was excellent both for the work as well as the defence.
