

Mr. Vojtěch Sýkora wrote a bachelor thesis on novels written after the Civil War with a focus on the representations of blacks, the majority of whom had been slaves before the war. The focus on family, passing, race relations, romances etc. were placed within the historical context of the post-war chaos of the period. Tourgee is the first author chronologically and wrote semi-autobiographically about North Carolina clan activities and the struggle for civil rights of former slaves; assassination attempts and legal issues of abandoned, as well as a sub-plot of romance reconciling the North and South symbolically. Frances Harper wrote a slave to North and South family saga which included an unrealistically happy ending. Chesnut focussed on ambitious blacks passing in order to rise in society - which turned out to be a much greater struggle than they anticipated. The analysis was not excellent but quite good after the lengthy time taken to write the thesis.
