

Průběh obhajoby bakalářské práce:

The candidate presented his bachelor thesis on three Brian Moore novels and the film adaptations, not explaining the plots but focussing on his own opinions regarding Moore's novels and how well he viewed the adaptations for the screen. His first question regarded another Catholic novelist's take on the wars and Mr. Schwarz successfully addressed the question as the works of Graham Greene's novels. The topic of being a Northern Irish Catholic (and consequently a minority) vs. a converted Englishman to Catholicism also came to the fore. Mr. Schwarz discussed how Moore's religion was, throughout his writing career, not just the lens by which his novels revealed conflicts, both personal and national, but also how Moore was highly critical of the corruption of the church -- for example in helping to hide a Nazi War criminal from justice. The assessment of Mr. Schwarz's bachelor thesis was assessed as excellent.
