The aim of the thesis was to analyse the social position of two characters by Jane Austen. However, too much attention is paid to Austen's biography and the era, so there is not much room for the analysis itself.

The author has collected some source material on Austen and her time. The presentation, however, leaves much to be desired, namely in terms of the language. Also the use of paraphrases is quite problematic as it is impossible to distinguish the author's contribution from the paraphrase.
